Special invitations are going to the Hispanic neighborhoods through nearby schools, newspapers and radio, as well as to Boy Scout and Girl Scout troops. ACS members are encouraged to come and bring their friends and elementary-aged children to visit the zoo October 12 to see young chemists educating and entertaining the children, and to see the many improvements and new animals at the zoo too.
