

# **FAQs** for the First Year Exam

All the information about the exam can be found on the website, <u>ocacs.org</u>. Click on the Education tab at the top, then select High School First Year Exam, then choose the Teacher First Year Exam Letter.

## Do I need a photo ID on the day of the exam?

Yes, IDs will be checked. Without a photo ID students will be permitted to take the exam, but will not be recognized as a winner unless a legitimate ID is provided before the end of the exam.

#### Do I need a calculator?

No, calculators are not allowed on this exam.

### How long is the exam?

The exam consists of about 90 multiple choice questions, and will last 2 hours maximum.

## What is the policy on cell phones?

While we realize that students may need a phone to call for a ride at the end of the exam, ALL CELL PHONES MUST BE TURNED OFF AND PUT AWAY during the exam. If a student is found to have a cell phone that is on, s/he will be disqualified.

# Can I leave to go to the restroom during the exam?

No, please use the restroom before starting the exam.

#### If I am late, can I still take the exam?

If you are later than 9:10 am, you will not be allowed to take the test.

## Can this exam be taken more than one time?

No, this is for first year students of chemistry only, and cannot be taken more than 1 time.

#### What happens if there is a tie for top student from my school?

There is an optional tie-breaker question at the end of the exam. It is not required, but serves to decide a tie between the top scoring students.

## How can I be sure I am registered?

We will try to send a confirmatory email to your teacher this year when s/he registers the student.

### When do I see the test results?

Results will be emailed to the chemistry teacher who completed the online registration for your school within one week of the exam.
